An early 20th century Indonesian kris dagger with straight-form blade, blade length 34.5cm, and wooden handle, carved in the form of Barong, with wooden scabbard (some repairs evident), together with a 20th century lance tip, length 24cm, detailed 'E. Broom & Co, Calcutta, made in England'.

Estimate: £50 - £80

Condition Report

1820. Rust patches to blade, some heavy in places. Handle loose to blade. Wear to handle. Some minor knocks. Scabbard glued, probably the lower half from the hilt later made. Chips and wear to the edges of the hilt receiver.
