A 19th century North African short sword with single-edged fullered blade, blade length 53cm, and one-piece rhino horn grip with embossed white metal retaining collar, with embossed white metal scabbard with single paste stone setting and woven material belt strap, together with some provenance and paperwork. Note: as this lot incorporates rhinoceros horn, it would be very unlikely that a re-export certificate would be granted beyond the UK. Customers outside the UK are requested NOT to bid on this item.

Condition Report

1821. Blade has some light patches of rust. Edge of blade has some chips. Point slightly misshapen. Hilt showing signs of some shrinkage to one side, some losses. Scabbard fittings loose in some places and splits forming. Fabric covering is perished and coming apart at seams.
