LOT 1823

A late 19th century Middle Eastern silver mounted jambia with curved blade, blade length 19cm, and chased and engraved silver metal grip with turquoise stone-inset pommel, with similarly decorated silver metal scabbard (some losses and dents).

Estimate: £100 - £150

Condition Report

1823. Some evidence of old rust to blade, now cleaned. Blade probably re-stuck into handle, though done to a good standard. Scabbard collar shows wear and some losses. Some minor marks to outside of main body, one deeper bruise. Loss to tip of scabbard, may originally have had an inset stone.
