An 18ct gold keywind hunting cased fob watch, the gilt movement detailed 'W. Abeling, London 1843', 18ct gold inner case, the enamelled dial with Roman numerals and subsidiary seconds, detailed 'D.W. Lee New York', the case exterior engine turned, London 1840, total weight 76.9g, case diameter 4.3cm (glass lacking).

1048. The watch winds smoothly and runs, but please be aware we give no guarantees to working order or reliability of any clock or watch. Seconds hand also runs as it should. Dial in good clean order except for a very small hairline from the edge at 6 o'clock to the edge of the subsidiary dial. Dial does not have a glass cover. Case in generally good condition with no significant damage or repairs. Both hinges in good order and front and back closing tightly. Wear to the engine turning to front and back, small dent to back of case at approx 2 o'clock. Some typical light surface scratches. Good clear hallmarks. All condition issues can be seen in the images on our website.
