An early George III silver pair cased keywind open-faced pocket watch, the gilt fusee movement with verge escapement, the backplate detailed 'Thos Brent London 3884', the enamelled dial with black Roman hour numerals and outer Arabic minute numerals, London 1764, the outer case back monogram engraved, inner case diameter 4cm, outer case diameter 4.7cm.

Condition Report

1046. The watch winds but does not run.

The dial in generally good condition with no significant damage or repairs. Faint hairline from centre to edge at 2 o'clock. Typical light surface scratches and wear. Glass has crack and chip to edge and typical scratches and wear.

Silver case in generally good condition, typical surface scratches and wear. Hinge is good.

Outer case in generally good order with typical wear and scratches. Engraved initials/monogram to back.

Hinge is good. Both inner and outer silver cases with good clear hallmarks.
