Condition Report

426. Generally good condition.

Bottle 1 - some typical very minor nicks to glass, but no significant damage or repairs. Silver cap has a couple of small dents and typical light wear, but screws down tightly.

Bottle 2 - some typical very minor nicks to glass, but no significant damage or repairs. Silver cap has a couple of small dents and one side pushed down slightly, typical light wear, but otherwise ok and screws down tightly.

Good clear marks to interiors.

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
