### LOT 1206

An early to mid-19th century brass inverted pendulum table clock with single train movement, the silvered circular dial with black Roman hour numerals and inscribed 'Tomlinson Thame', framing an inner calendar ring, all within a gilt bronze surround, the frame supporting a nine rod compensated pendulum, total height 56.5cm (some faults).

Estimate: £200 - £400

### Condition Report

1206. The clock is in generally poor condition and in need of some attention. It is very dirty and dusty. Dial is worn, ormolu surround is dirty and pitted, frame and movement very dirty. The movement winds smoothly, but we do not know whether it would run or if any minor components may be missing. The pendulum has a broken suspension spring.
