A late 19th century walnut Vienna wall timepiece with long duration movement, possibly month going, the two piece enamel dial with Roman hour numerals and inscribed 'Carl Suchy & Sohne Wien', the case with moulded pediment above a glazed door with Ionic columns and tapered apron, height 115.5cm, with pendulum and brass weight.

Condition Report

1156. Case is a little tired with some wear and veneer loss/splits to pediment and sides. Some warping to mouldings. Missing its arched surmount. Dial in generally good condition with small hairline between 4 & 5. Some rust visible to movement.
