LOT 1210

A George III and later stained pine longcase clock with thirty hour movement striking on a bell via an outside countwheel, the 10-inch square brass dial signed 'John Foot Liskard', the hood with moulded pediment, the trunk with rectangular door, on a plain base and plinth, weight 207cm, with pendulum and weight (faults, alterations and restoration).

Estimate: £50 - £80

Condition Report

1210. The movement and case are obviously a marriage, so did not start life together. The case is stained pine and not a particularly good case, for example the trunk door has no hinges and hood door has no glass. Typical scuffs and splits.

Movement and dial are a bit dirty, but seem otherwise ok. Pendulum bob is broken off, but still present, therefore cannot tell whether it runs or not.
