A late 19th century French gilt metal mantel clock with eight day movement striking on a bell via an outside countwheel, the circular porcelain dial painted with a cherub and basket framed by black Roman hour numerals, the case cast with foliate sprays and inset with a Sèvres style porcelain panel, decorated with a courting couple beneath an urn finial, height 38cm, with pendulum and winding key.

Estimate: £100 - £150

Condition Report

1124 - Generally good condition with no significant damage or repairs. Case is a bit dusty and dirty. Porcelain in good condition but some wear to gilt on dial. The movement winds smoothly and starts to run but please be aware we give no guarantees to working order or reliability of any clock or watch. The strike mechanism also working.

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
