A 20th century French gilt metal cased and porcelain mantel clock with eight day movement striking on a bell via an outside countwheel, the case cast with scrolls, swags and foliate bands, inset with porcelain dial and front panel, painted with a cherub and courting couple, height 46cm, with pendulum and winding key.

Condition Report

1125 - Generally fairly good condition with no significant damage or repairs. The case is a bit dirty and dusty. The porcelain is all in good condition, however the urn surmount may well be a replacement as the colour of the porcelain and painting is a little different. There is typical light surface scratches and some wear to gilt.
