A Ridgway porcelain teapot, cover and stand, circa 1820-25, the bulbous body finely moulded with crowns and cornucopia enclosing floral painting beneath a cobalt blue ground moulded trellis, picked out in gilt, the teapot cover with butterfly finial, pattern No. 2/852, together with a similar trio, pattern No. 2/835, a plate, pattern No. 893, diameter 22.3cm, another plate, pattern No. 892, a green ground moulded trio and matching saucer dish, pattern No. 2/829, and two pale blue ground moulded saucer dishes, pattern No. 2/823.

Condition Report

Teapot - in very good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration, there is some very minor and light wear to the gilt edge of the cover.

Cobalt blue ground teacup - very small haircrack approx 5mm to rim with some light crazing to the glaze around the top edge of the rim. The coffee cup has similar very fine crazing. Teapot stand with very light wear to the gilding otherwise in good condition, the cobalt blue plate in good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration.

Green ground pieces - Teacup with some wear to gilt edge of foot, otherwise all pieces in good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration.

Remaining pieces - each in good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration.
