A Ridgway porcelain gilt decorated part service, mid-19th century, with flower sprays flanked by foliate scroll edged trellis panels, pattern No. 5/1801, comprising two-handled plate, length 26.5cm, jug, five teacups, four coffee cups and seven saucers, together with a pair of Ridgway two-handled comports, mid-19th century, painted to the centre with floral bouquets within gilt edged pierced turquoise glazed borders, pattern No. 6/4712, and two other Ridgway oval two-handled dishes.

Estimate: £80 - £120

Condition Report

One coffee cup finely crazed overall with some very minor staining, another coffee cup with very indistinct and minor vertical hairline to rim with some minor crazing. Otherwise each part of gilt service in good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration, there is some typical light wear to the gilding commensurate with age and use.

Pair comports - one with very short indistinct haircrack to rim by pierced section - very inconsequential - otherwise both in good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration.

Two oval dishes - magenta ground dish with very minor hairline to rim beneath handle, very indistinct, otherwise both in good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration.
