A group of mostly Ridgway porcelain cabinet plates and tablewares, 19th century, including a two-handled low-footed dish, painted with a central riverside view of ruins within a gilt overlaid turquoise rim, reserved with floral panels, length 26.5cm, a cream ground plate, painted with three floral panels within raised gilt scroll framing, flanked by low relief moulded flower detail, pattern No. 732, diameter 22cm, and a cobalt blue ground square dish, painted with flowers, length 22cm (minor faults).

Estimate: £150 - £250

Condition Report

Low footed dish with turquoise rim - long scratch to underside rim edge, otherwise in good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration.

Plate with central bird - some light crazing to the glaze.

Otherwise each piece in lot in good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration. There is some typical light wear/surface scratches commensurate with age and use, but nothing untoward.
