A collection of English porcelain cups and saucers, 19th century, including a Spode bute shaped teacup and saucer, both printed with rural scenes, a Chamberlains Worcester coffee can and saucer gilt with acorns above grey marbling, a topographical Derby teacup and saucer, a Davenport trio with simple floral sprays, a green ground Davenport teacup and saucer with gilt star and dot decoration, a gilt decorated Ridgway trio, pattern No. 5/1728, a Ridgway breakfast cup and saucer, a Ridgway blue ground trio and a Davenport cup and saucer, painted with fancy birds, various factory marks.

Condition Report

Overall the lot is in good condition overall with no restoration or chips, there is typical light wear/surface scratches commensurate with age and use. A few little things to point out on some of the lot follows;

Pink rosebud and gilt leaf - has some crazing to the teacup.

Black and red teacup and saucer, pattern number 308 - both pieces overall finely crazed.

Grey ground floral panel, pattern number 5/2717 - both pieces crazed and hairline to saucer.

Cream ground and floral - teacup heavily crazed.

Marbled saucer - crazed.

Cobalt blue with gilt whorls and red flowers, pattern number 2/1015 - vertical haircrack to rim of teacup.

Derby View in Wales teacup and saucer - starcrack to saucer, both pieces heavily crazed.
