A Turner white feldspathic stoneware mug, circa 1800, sprigged with figures taking an archery lesson between chocolate brown ribbed bands, unmarked, height 10.5cm, together with three other pieces of stoneware, comprising a sleeping figure with a dog at his feet, a jug with bifurcated handle by Ridgway and a flower moulded cylindrical inkwell.

Estimate: £40 - £60

Condition Report

Mug - small loss to sprigged hunting horn hung in tree, otherwise in good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration.

Figure - small chip to underside front rim edge of hat, otherwise in good condition.

Jug - In good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration.

Inkwell - approx 3cm long haircrack to upper rim circumference, otherwise ok.
