A pair of Pilkington's Lancastrian bottle vases, circa 1911, both covered in a semi-lustrous orange glaze, impressed marks to bases, height 18cm.

Estimate: £150 - £250

Condition Report

Both with overall fine crazing to the glaze. Each also has a small chip to the inner rim edge of the footrim, neither of which are noticeable when the vase is stood on a flat surface. No cracks or restoration.

Both of the vases have manufacturers glaze faults, these are not damage but a production issue - on one vase this is noticeable as a patch on the neck and a vertical line 2 cm long on the widest part of the body, on the other vase it is again a patch on the neck.
