### LOT 1612

A Meissen chocolate cup and cover, 19th century, probably outside decorated, the ogee cup painted with Artemis the goddess of hunting within a gilt border, otherwise decorated with floral sprays within a gilt geometric rim, the cover with flower bud finial, crossed swords in underglaze blue to base, total height 9.5cm.

Estimate: £80 - £120

### Condition Report

The cup is in good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration. There is a small concave manufacturing blemish to the top edge of the rim above the portrait which has been decorated over during production.

The cover has areas of black pitting to the glaze - suggesting a re-firing process - and there are a few small chips to the petals of the bud finial.
