### LOT 1634

A Moorcroft Pansy pattern teapot and cover, circa 1940, impressed marks to base, height 14.5cm (bruise to glaze on handle).

Estimate: £50 - £80

### Condition Report

Both pieces with typical overall fine crazing to the glaze but no cracks, chips or restoration.

The 'bruise to glaze on handle' refers to a minor manufacturing blemish to the top side edge of the handle which has caused the glaze to take on an oval appearance on a small patch.

There is a 1cm long scratch to the end side edge of the spout which has a small patch of misfired glaze beside it.
