Three glass decanter bottles with seals, probably late 18th century, of olive green tint and rectangular form with rounded shoulders, each with indistinct crowned 'LONDON' seal above a 'B'(?), height of pair of narrow form 17.8cm, height of wider example 17.2cm.

Estimate: £200 - £300

Condition Report

One of the pair of narrow form has a small area of surface scratches to the exterior, fairly inconsequential, otherwise both are in good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration.

The wider example is also in good condition overall but has a vertical blemish approx 1.5cm long to the neck interior which resembles a haircrack - it cannot be felt to the exterior though and does not go through the string rim.
