### LOT 1736

A pair of ruby flashed cut glass vases, probably Bohemian, late 19th/early 20th century, of decagonal baluster shape, alternate sides painted with shield shaped panels of knights and other equestrian figures framed by gilt scrollwork, the overturned rims with hobnail panels, on scalloped feet, height 22.5cm.

Estimate: £250 - £350

### Condition Report

Both vases are overall in good condition with typical light wear/rubbing/scratches to the decoration commensurate with age and use.

The first vase has 2 small chips to the edge of the foot, very inconsequential.

The second vase has 3 small chips to the overturned top rim edge - hardly noticeable apart from on very close inspection - and a partly polished chip to the foot.
