### LOT 1810

A small pair of clear glass lustres, early 19th century, the baluster stems with facet and collar detail, the flat rims with rib cut decoration, both hung with ten prismatic drops above the star cut circular bases, height 14.5cm, each with a plated nozzle.

Estimate: £200 - £300

### Condition Report

Both lustres are overall in good condition. One has a minor bruise to the widest part of the stem - only noticeable on close inspection - and the other has some minor chips/nicks to the top rim exterior, fairly inconsequential.

The pendant drops all match and have only minor typical nicks.
