### LOT 1565

A pearlware pottery bust of Newton, early 19th century, with turquoise and lilac glazed clothing, raised on a socle base, impressed 'NEWTON' to reverse, height 22cm (minor chips to base).

### Condition Report

All four corners of square base chipped. Some black pitting to glaze on front of base and back of bust. Small pinhead sized glaze flake to turquoise part of clothing at front and minor haircrack approx 7mm long to raised lilac part of collar on right shoulder - both these last 2 things fairly inconsequential.
