Condition Report

Spotted bowl - In good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration. There are some typical light surface scratches to the body overall and normal wear to the foot. The top rim edge has some deeper scratches/spots of wear.

Amber bowl - In good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration, typical minor and light surface scratches.

Striated bowl - a few 'digs' to upper rim edge, scratches to base interior. Generally ok.
