A small group of mostly Royal commemorative pottery and porcelain, late 19th and 20th century, including a Shelley George VI Coronation loving cup, a Doulton Edward VIII beaker, Aynsley, Paragon and Wedgwood, together with a Stevenson & Hancock Derby floral painted coffee cup and saucer and three Staffordshire pieces.

Estimate: £60 - £100

Condition Report

The Royal commemoratives are each overall in good condition with no cracks, chips or restoration. There is some typical light wear commensurate with age and use but nothing untoward. The green ground Copeland beaker has some scratches to the green ground.

Teacup and saucer - In good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration. The saucer has some light crazing.

Staffordshire figure - heavily crazed with flaking to the enamels.

Miniature teapot - in good condition overall.

House - heavily crazed, minor chip to chimney and indistinct minor losses to applied detail.
