Four pieces of Royal commemorative pottery, comprising a black printed jug, circa 1830, commemorating the death of King George IV, height 13.5cm, a Copeland 'Transvaal War 1900' tyg, a Copeland two-handled vase commemorating the death of King Edward VII and a coffee can commemorating the death of Princess Charlotte (some restoration).

Estimate: £120 - £180

Condition Report

Black printed George IV jug - heavily crazed, badly stained, chipped and cracked.

Charlotte coffee can - extensively restored.

Copeland tyg - 3 vertical cracks running height of body professionally but noticeably restored.

Copeland vase - heavily crazed overall with 2 restored chips to the rim and 2 smaller to the foot.
