### LOT 1555

A Clément Massier lustre pottery jardinière bowl, circa 1900, decorated by Lucien Levy-Dhurmer, monogrammed, with pinecones and needles, painted and impressed marks to base, height 19cm (minor faults).

### Condition Report

There is a crack to the base running around the whole of the inner footrim circumference with various small branches running off, one larger branch runs off across the footrim and disappears into the lower body of the vase where it is absorbed into the overall crazing of the vase. A fainter multiple branched starcrack is visible to the middle of the base underside. There is in addition a minor glaze frit to the edge of the footrim.

There are a number of small glaze frits/chips to the upper rim edge.

There are a number of blemishes/flaws in the glaze, e.g., to the base interior, which are a manufacturing issue and do not detract from the vase.
