A French porcelain butter tub and cover, probably Boissette, late 18th century, of oval shape with upright lug handles, painted in underglaze blue with flowers and insects beneath a geometric band against a moulded rim, the cover with entwined scroll handle, incised mark to base, length 12.5cm (minor nicks to handle of cover).

Estimate: £80 - £120

Condition Report

The tub has 2 fine vertical haircracks running from the rim to the base on one side, one to the side of the decoration, the other through it.

The cover has 3 tiny nicks to the middle of the handle.

Otherwise in good condition.
