A Spanish faience monastic albarello, Talavera, late 17th/18th century, of waisted form, painted in blue with a Catholic armorial surmounted by an abbot's hat, hung with six tassels to each side, above a label inscribed 'PVM.LOM', height 25.3cm (restored). Note: this armorial relates to the Order of Our Lady of Mercy. A similar example is illustrated by Rudolf E.A. Drey in 'Apothecary Jars', p. 145, pl. 74b. Provenance: from the collection of the late Professor Maurice Stacey, previously sold in these rooms 19th November 2020, Lot 1268.

Condition Report

1695. Broken and reglued V-shaped section to rim, 3cm x 5cm. 9cm diagonal crack to rim running down over the shoulder. 6cm vertical crack to rim, with 8cm diagonal hairline running off from the vertical crack and a 6cm horizontal hairline at its terminal. Minor rim chips and typical light wear and surface scratches.
