Condition Report

1696. There are four vertical cracks to the rim, 4cm, 8.5cm, 5cm and 6cm in length, also smaller glaze hairlines running off from these principal cracks. Also few minor cracks to rim and footrim. Typical crazing to glaze, surface scratches and wear.
