A set of four Continental Meissen style two-handled porcelain baskets, late 19th/early 20th century, each of pierced oval form with floral moulded decoration and painted study of fruit, heightened in gilt, pseudo marks to bases, length 21cm (some restoration).

Estimate: £70 - £100

Condition Report

1598 - 1 - One handle restored. Couple of small chips to the green foliage on the exterior. A few losses to the painted decoration on the interior.

2 - Firing crack to the handle where it joins the body. On the exterior on the same side of the bowl, minor losses to the blue glaze of the ribbon. Chip to foot rim approx 0.7mm in size.

3 - One handle restored. One encrusted berry missing. A couple of losses to the blue glaze of the ribbon.

4 - Some minor loss to the interior painted decoration. Small chip to foot rim. Overall some minor wear to the gilt decoration and to the high points.
