A Belleek Glass kettle and cover, first black mark, 1863-90, height 15cm, together with a mixed group of other Belleek wares, including a three strand shamrock basket (restored), two shell shaped butter dishes, a larger shell plate, and a leaf plate, diameter 20cm, various teawares and a Royal Doulton figure Rose, HN1368 (minor faults and restoration).

Estimate: £60 - £100

Condition Report

1683. Scallop shell dish - chip to underside of handle.

Pot and cover - extensively resored.

Larger leaf shaped dish - a few minor chips to rim.

Basket - restoration to each encrusted floral spray.

Vase - small losses to encrusted decoration on both sides of the vase. Some restoration to tim, to left of main flowerhead.

Teapot - minor wear to gilt, otherwise in good condition.

Other pieces in generally good condition, very minor wear to centre of saucers.
