A Meissen figure of Sleeping Louise, late 19th century, modelled by Acier after a painting by Greuze as a girl asleep in a chair, her arm resting on a table, a letter tucked into her bodice, raised on a shaped 'paved' base, crossed swords in underglaze blue to base, incised shape No. E58, height 18.5cm.

## Condition Report

This figure is in very good condition overall with no restoration.

There is a teeny tiny chip to the end of one blue ribbon in her hair and a manufacturer's firing crack to one central strut of the table - both of which are only noticeable on VERY close inspection. Otherwise there are typical teeny tiny losses to the lace detail but nothing untoward or terrible and hardly any losses in reality.
