A Wedgwood pale green jasper dip oval plaque depicting Admiral Sir John Jervis, First Earl of St Vincent, post-1798, modelled by John de Vaere, impressed and incised marks to reverse, height 11.2cm, together with a miniature Wedgwood dark blue jasper dip teapot, cover and stand, 19th century, typically sprigged in white, height of teapot 7cm. Note: the portrait plaque is one of a set of four modelled by de Vaere of great naval heroes.

Condition Report

Plaque - 2 minuscule nicks to the upper rim edge at 10 and 12 o'clock, there is a fine approx 4cm long hairline to the reverse of the plaque through the title - it cannot be seen to the upper surface and is not able to be felt with your fingernail.

Teapot - pinhead sized nick to tip of spout, otherwise in good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration.

Stand - In good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration.
