## LOT 2430

A Doulton Lambeth gilt metal mounted stoneware table oil lamp, circa 1883, decorated by Edith Lupton, monogrammed, the domed foot with small white flowers on scrolling stems against a brown ground, surmounted by a twisted brass stem supporting a bucket shaped stoneware housing for the glass reservoir, with Hink's Duplex burner, glass chimney and etched shade, incised and impressed factory marks to stoneware, height to top of burner 47cm.

Estimate: £70 - £100

## Condition Report

2430 - The stoneware parts of the lamp appear to be in good condition. One of the fleurs-de-lys brass shaped pieces has snapped off but is present. The other brass parts are tarnished and have age related wear. No other obvious damage or restoration.
