A Haviland & Co Art Nouveau Chaplet stoneware vase, circa 1885, the textured brown ground ovoid body incised, painted and applied with blossom branches and leaves, enamelled and gilt, beneath a similarly decorated brown glazed neck, impressed and incised marks to base, height 28.5cm (chips to foot), together with a similarly decorated small Haviland jug, height 11.3cm.

Estimate: £200 - £300

Condition Report

Vase - 7 noticeable large chips to the foot. 2 of the relief flowerheads to the body of the vase with insignificant chips to the petals. Wear to gilding. Otherwise in good condition with no cracks or restoration.

Jug - tiny nick to spout, otherwise in good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration.
