A large Italian maiolica twin snake handled vase, probably Cantagalli, late 19th/early 20th century, the rounded body painted with a continuous scene of classical figures, including Diana with Cupid to one side and a Bacchic scene to the other, the handles with mask terminals, indistinct blue painted mark to base, height 67cm.

Estimate: £300 - £400

Condition Report

There is professional restoration to both of the handles, some of the footrim edge and around the top of the foot where it joins to the base of the vase. All of this restoration is incredibly well done and only noticeable by an expert eye. In addition there is associated clear spraying to the neck behind the handles and to the rim.
