A Ridgway porcelain cabinet plate, circa 1845-50, pattern No. 6/2767, painted with a central still life study of a flower basket on a marble ledge beside a pineapple, the cobalt blue rim reserved with salmon pink foliate scrollwork and trellis panels, edged in gilding, diameter 23.5cm (fine starcrack), together with a Ridgway Bates & Company cabinet plate, circa 1856-58, painted with a boy tying a girl's shoe within a gilt overlaid cream border, unmarked, diameter 23.3cm. Note: a similar plate is illustrated by Geoffrey Godden in 'The Illustrated Guide to Ridgway Porcelains', pl. 139.

Estimate: £80 - £120

Condition Report

Still life plate - overall fine crazing to the glaze which includes a faint branched starcrack amidst the crazing to the middle of the underside, despite this the plate still 'rings' nicely. Some stacking wear to the gilt cavetto. Otherwise enamels and gilding bright with no chips or restoration.

Figural plate - In good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration. Some typical light surface scratches, nothing untoward.
