### LOT 1569

A Doulton Lambeth Silicone stoneware water filter and cover, 1880s, with overall bands of geometric decoration against a buff ground, impressed factory marks, height 56cm, with replacement spigot, together with a Doulton Silicone stoneware cheese dome and stand (minor faults).

Estimate: £60 - £100

### Condition Report

The tap hole has 2 small chips to the edge, the tap itself is likely to be a replacement.

There is an approx 2.2cm square unsprung chip/flaw to the body of the filter between the top of the foot and the lower decoration on the body, this is likely to be as a result of a firing flaw/crack.

The cover has an 'S' shaped firing crack to the top of finial and another curving around the base of the finial.

The cheese dome stand is in good order with overall surface scratches, the dome itself is missing a number of sprigged elements, particularly to the row of blue flowerheads nearer the base.
