Condition Report

325. In generally good condition. Noticeable small dent just above the foot on one candlestick. Both are engraved with armorial crests on the foot, and have wear to the gadrooned decoration from enthusiastic polishing. Minor age related wear.

Hallmarks on sconces are matching and readable, but one slightly rubbed.
