A group of nine silver lidded cut glass dressing table jars, various dates, including a powder jar, London 1921, height 8cm, and a pair of silver rectangular foliate engraved lids, Sheffield 1879 by John Hunter, length 9cm, total weight excluding glass 216.5g, together with a cut glass rectangular dish with silver rim, length 24cm, and a silver mounted comb.

Condition Report

387. Powder jar has a few small chips to the rim of the glass, the lid is in good condition.

The rectangular tray, the single circular jar and cover, and the Art Nouveau long oval jar and cover are all in good condition.

All other items have visible dents to the silver and minor chips to the glass.
