### LOT 1618

A large pair of Paris porcelain Meissen style figures, late 19th century, modelled as a lady and gentleman in 18th century dress, he holding a dove, she with a floral posy, on circular naturalistic bases applied with flowers and shredded grass, underglaze blue factory marks to bases, heights 68cm and 66cm (minor faults and restoration).

Estimate: £150 - £250

### Condition Report

Generally overall in good condition with some professional restoration to both figures, e.g., hands, small section of flower encrusting on lady held on with wire where restored on left hand.

Typical losses to applied flowers and foliage, also missing some other minor relief details, e.g., lacework on lady's dress.

Minor chips to bases and very minor wear to enamels.

Some typical firing cracks to bases due to size of figures.
