A gold mounted oval shell cameo brooch, carved as a portrait of Bacchus with wine cup and lyre motifs, the later mount with an applied bead and arcaded border, unmarked, weight 33.8g, width 6.1cm.

Condition Report

580. The edges of the cameo have been trimmed and the mount with an added front rim, with supporting sections in three places at the back. Hinge pin is repositioned. The cameo is ill fitting in its setting. The beadwork surround in good condition. The mount is later than the 19th century carved cameo.
