A Victorian gold and foil backed rock crystal pendant brooch, circa 1850, of scroll pierced and lozenge shaped form, mounted with a row of three colour foil backed rock crystals, with a pendant drop suspended from chains, unmarked, weight 14.6g, length including drop 9.3cm, width 5.6cm, with the original fitted case.

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## Condition Report

593. There is a roller security clasp to the pin, this is a later edition. The pin is bent at the hinge end. The hinge itself is rather pushed downwards slightly distorting the design. Overall good condition for age.  
Case ♦ the exterior is a little scuffed, would benefit from a wax polish.

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
