A Victorian silver set, gilt backed and diamond necklace, mounted with cushion cut diamonds, the principal diamond mounted at the front, on a blue and colourless paste cluster clasp, unmarked, weight 18.9g, principal diamond weight approx 1.50ct, colour approx L, clarity approx SI2, total diamond weight approx 11.00-12.00ct, length 39.5cm.

Estimate: £6,000 - £8,000

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### Condition Report

595. The clasp is in association with the necklace. The necklace would originally have had a pendant drop because there is a hinged loop attached to the mount of the principal diamond. Overall good condition. Principal diamond setting approx. 8mm x 7.5mm. The next two principal diamond settings each diameter approx 4mm. The stones ever so slightly graduate so there is some slight variation of setting size. Principal diamond colour approx. L, clarity approx. SI2. Averages of other diamonds, colour approx. L, clarity approx SI.
