A gold ring, circa 1800, probably Continental, glazed to the centre with a painted miniature depicting two classical figures within a blue enameled surround, unmarked, weight 6.9g, ring size approx I1/2 (shank slightly distorted). Condition Report

618. There is some damage to the puce painted miniature painting resulting in some loss of the design. The central panel has been remounted into the current setting, some evidence of glue around the edge in support of this opinion. Some wear to the engraved decoration. The shank is rather thin and misshapen to oval.
