A gold and rose cut diamond pendant brooch, 18th century, probably Iberian, in a scroll pierced and engraved openwork design, the front with a pendant drop, with a later brooch fitting, unmarked, weight 21.6g, total length 7cm, width 6cm, with an associated Asprey & Company Limited case. 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### Condition Report

625. The pin and roller clasp are replaced. The diamonds are a little grey with some abrasion to the side of the principal diamond. The gold work is in good condition.

Principal two diamonds approx 4mm x 4mm, approx 4mm x 2mm.

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
