A white gold, diamond and emerald pendant necklace, circa 1920, the pendant mounted with a rose cut diamond set vase of flowers motif on an emerald ground, the quatrefoil shaped surround mounted with four principal cushion cut diamonds, length 3.9cm, fitted to a white gold twin bar link neckchain, spaced with emerald beads at intervals, on a rose cut diamond set snap clasp, fitted with a safety chain and boltring, unmarked, length 53.3cm, total weight 16.2g, with the original fitted case.

Condition Report

650. Cabochon emerald ground to the pendant is of medium to pale colour saturation and it has numerous inclusions, some of which are surface reaching. The emerald beads are generally of medium to pale colour saturation with numerous inclusions some of which are surface reaching. The diamonds to the pendant have some variation of cut and size, mostly have one or two inclusions. Overall condition is good.
