A silver watch Albert chain in a decorated twisted bar and knot link design, fitted with a T-bar and swivel, detailed 'S.BRS', another swivel, detailed 'S.S', and a pendant locket, decorated with the head of a greyhound and riding crop, Birmingham 1893, total weight 57g, length 36.2cm.

Condition Report

679. Slight wear to the connecting loops of the chain. The swivels are in good working order. One of the twisted bar links is cut through at one end. The swivel detailed ♦S.S♦ is in association. The swivel detailed ♦S.BRS♦ is also marked with an ♦R♦ date letter and lion passant. The T-bar is just marked ♦S BRS♦, the S is very faint. Neither are modern. The pendant locket is a little dented. The three oval links at the S.S swivel end are not marked. Some of the oval/circular links by the T-bar are not marked. Most other links are marked with lion passant.

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
