## LOT 708

A gold, cabochon sapphire and aquamarine set brooch, circa 1940, designed as a daisy flower, stem and two leaves, detailed '14K', weight 6.2g, width 5.5cm.

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## Condition Report

The pin and clasp are original to the piece. The safety hook of the clasp is slightly bent making it difficult to pull back fully to release the pin.

One aquamarine has a small chip hidden beneath a claw. One or two of the aquamarines have small chips to the girdle noticeable under magnification.

Claws in good condition, all stones look secure in their settings.

Some typical light surface wear.

Would benefit from a clean.

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
